What has happened that leads the Division of Children and Family Services (DCFS) to be concerned?	
Harm statement (provisional): It was reported that Robin and Eric were intoxicated and began arguing. Robin and Eric became physical. Robin shoved Eric, and Eric slapped Robin, giving her a bruise on her eye and a bloody nose. Children were present and witnessed the fight. The children's ages are Anne, 12; Beth, 11; Sean, 9; and Jeremy 4.	
What is the department and/or the family concerned will happen to the children if nothing else changes?	
The children could be physically harmed or traumatized when Robin and Eric become drunk, fight, push, slap, or become verbally violent with each other. The children will continue to be scared and confused when Robin and Eric engage in domestic violence, causing them to run to their bedrooms and turn up the TV or play video games.	
What actions need to be taken to ensure the children are safe?	Who is responsible for ensuring this action occurs?
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Robin and Eric will remove all alcohol from the home, and they have agreed not to consume alcohol around the children. If Robin and Eric consume any alcohol or plan to consume alcohol at home or another location, they will call Mike and Kathy to care for the children. If Robin and Eric begin to fight, the children will go to Judy's house immediately. Robin and Eric have agreed to post the phone numbers for Mike, Kathy, Bill, and Judy on the refrigerator door for the children to access. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The worker will contact Mike and Kathy and confirm their willingness to stay with and care for the children if Eric and Robin are drinking and/or fighting. The worker will remain in communication with Mike and Kathy. Kathy and Judy have agreed to check on the children each of the next three days. (Kathy will come in the mornings before the children go to school, and Judy will come in the evenings around dinnertime) to ensure Robin and Eric are sober and the children are safe. The worker will return to the home in the next two days to confirm that item 1 from the "actions" column has been completed. The worker will contact Judy and confirm her willingness to stay with and care for the children if Eric and Robin are drinking and/or fighting. The worker will remain in communication with Judy.

While we may not agree on the details of these worries, we do agree to follow the plan until the review date. We know that if the plan does not keep all children safe, we must work together to create a new plan, or the department may take legal action.
