

Build a Box PPT Guide

The Building the Box PPT can help supplement the Building the Box exercise in the current training.

Prior to starting the PPT, determine which class members or groups will have each question.

- You may want to combine the cards into one word doc per student or class, to make sharing easier. For example, Group 1 may get a word doc with three of the Build a Box cards. Ideally, these would not sequential. Group 1 might have cards 2, 7, and 15.
- Share your prepared Build a Box Cards with either groups or individuals. This will be determines by the class size.

Begin the PPT. The “corners” of the box are on slide 3.

Up to slide 4 it's a regular PPT

On Slide 4, click 1.

- A card title appears; i.e., Investigation Preparation
- The title and the tile expands
- Ask the class member or group who has that card to read it to the group
- After they read the card, click again and the text they just read will appear.
- Click the text in the back button.
- That brings up the same view as in slide 4. This time, click 2. A new title appears.
- Continue through the presentation until you have covered all the materials.
- **Note: You have to click the numbers sequentially. Otherwise it gets wonky.**
