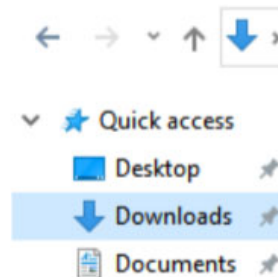


# VHS PC Installation Instructions


1. Follow the link you were provided to begin downloading VHS. Depending on your web browser settings, you may be asked where you would like to save the file, or it will automatically select the Downloads directory and begin downloading immediately. If you are asked where to save and select a directory other than Downloads, follow this guide with your selected directory in mind.
2. Once the download has completed, open File Explorer on your PC either by searching for File Explorer or by clicking the File Explorer icon (pictured below) at the bottom of the screen.



3. Navigate to the Downloads directory (or wherever you selected to save it in step 1) within Finder. It should be listed on the left side of the Finder window under the Favorites category.



4. Within the Downloads directory, locate the zip file starting with VHS. From here you can optionally move VHS to another location on your system, such as your desktop. To do that, simply drag VHS from the Downloads directory to the location you would like it to access it in the future.





- Once you have found VHS and possibly moved it to where you would like the application to be located, either right click on the .zip file and select to Extract All, or double click the .zip file and select Extract all in the top of the file browser window (pictured below)

- Click on Extract in the bottom right side of the window that should pop up. Note that you may click Browse to choose a specific location where you would like VHS to be located prior to clicking Extract. If so, make sure to navigate to the folder you chose before continuing to the next step of this document.



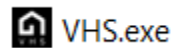
Extract Compressed (Zipped) Folders

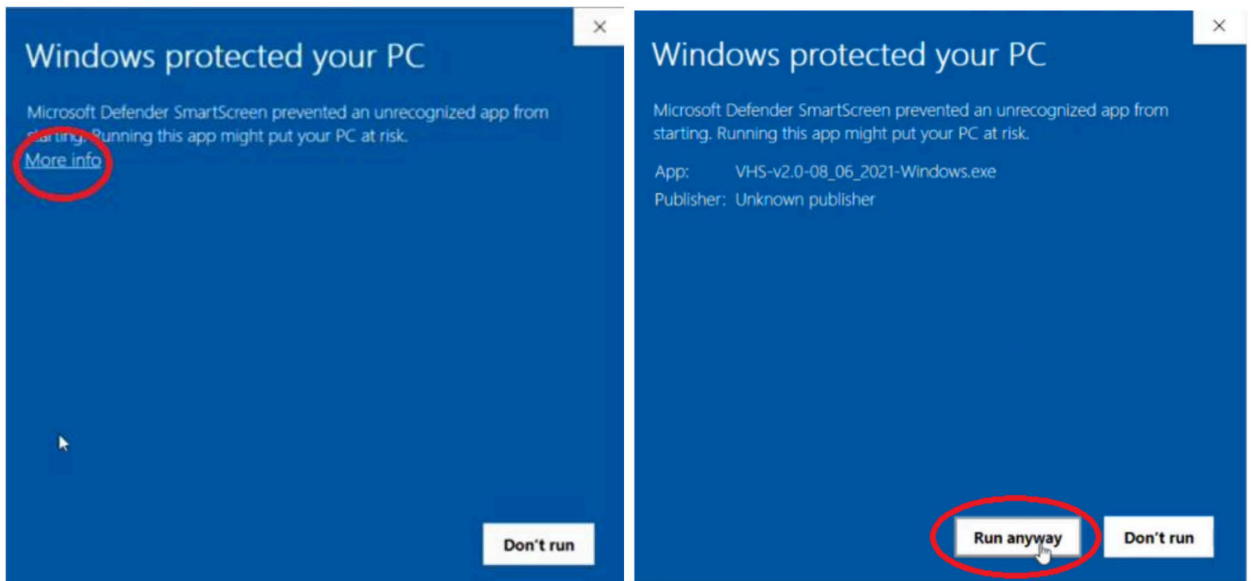

7. It may take some time to extract all the data. Once it has completed, navigate to the folder to which you extracted VHS (it may automatically open the folder for you if you left the checkbox checked in the previous step) and double click on the VHS icon (as seen below). Note that it may not have the “.exe” at the end of the VHS, depending on your settings, but it should have the same black and white icon as seen below.



8. It may then display a screen as seen below on which you click “More info” and then “Run anyway”. This step is unlikely, however, and you will most likely be able to move on to step 9.



- From here, VHS should load to the login screen. If this is your first time using VHS, click Sign up at the bottom of the screen, otherwise simply enter your email and password and click Login.
